SUBJECT: CONTRACTOR ALERT REPORTING DATABASE STATUS REPORT -

JULY 2025

On April 27, 2010, the Board of Supervisors directed the Chief Executive Office, Auditor-Controller (A-C), County Counsel, and the Director of the Internal Services Department to develop a mechanism to alert departments of poorly performing contractors. The result was the Contractor Alert Reporting Database (CARD or Database), which uses the County's enterprise-based eCAPS system to track poorly performing contractors. This is our July 2025 status report on contractors placed in and recommended for CARD.

Key Updates

Since our June 2025 status report, one contractor (Lake Hughes Recovery) has been placed in the Database with four active issues (highlighted on Attachments I and II). In addition, two contractors (Stirling Academy, Inc. and California Institute of Health and Social Services, Inc. dba Alafia Mental Health Institute) that were previously recommended for CARD resolved their non-compliance issues to avoid CARD placement and will no longer be included in future reports (highlighted in Attachment III).



As of July 2, 2025, 62 contractors, totaling 150 active issues, have been placed in the Database, and seven contractors are recommended for CARD placement.

Since our June 2025 status report, one contractor has been placed in the Database and two contractors resolved their non-compliance issues to avoid CARD placement.
