5. Hearing on application for a Massage Establishment Business License ID# 005571-02-2025, to issue a renewal license to Rowland Massage Inc., located at 1758 Sierra Leone Avenue, Suite D, Rowland Heights, CA 91748, in the First District. (26-1867)

Prior to discussion, Ms. Yi Shao interpreted for (Owner) Mr. Jinon Shao where he was informed that due to a lack of a quorum, testimony for this item would be heard by Hearing Officers and a recommendation would be made at the next regular meeting where there is a quorum. Mr. Shao agreed to be heard.

Eric Barnes, with the Treasurer and Tax Collector's Office (TTC), reported that the applicant had received all the necessary approvals and that TTC had no objection to the license being approved.

Mr. Shao later responded to questions posed by the Commission through Ms. Yi Shao who interpreted for him. He stated that the business provides full body massages in one open space. There are no rooms for patrons. The hours of operation are from 10:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m., daily. He has five certified technicians with an onsite manager available during business hours. There are no cameras and laundry is done in-house.

During further discussion, Mr. Shao was instructed to submit updated certifications of all technicians to TTC. Should his business acquire rooms, there should be no locks on the doors.

No members of the public addressed the Commission.

After discussion, Vice President Gonzalez and Commissioner Madarian noted this item will be continued to the next meeting where there is a quorum and would recommend approval of the application.

- 6.** Hearing on application for a Massage Establishment Business License ID# 002914-09-2024, to issue a renewal license to Daily Calm LLC dba Daily Calm Wellness, located at 23410 Civic Center Way, Malibu, CA 90265, in the Third District. (26-1874)

Prior to discussion, Ms. Andrea Mc Lennon was informed that due to a lack of a quorum, testimony for this item would be heard by Hearing Officers and a recommendation would be made at the next regular meeting where there is a quorum. Ms. Mc Lennon agreed to be heard.

Eric Barnes, with the Treasurer and Tax Collector's Office (TTC), reported that the applicant had received all the necessary approvals and that TTC had no objection to the license being approved.

Ms. Mc Lennon responded to questions posed by the Commission. She stated that in 2020, the business moved to its current location due to COVID. The business provides body massages and has two machines that assist with facials and evasive body contouring. The hours of operation are Tuesdays, Thursdays, Fridays, and Saturdays from 10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., and Sundays from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. She has four certified technicians and one desk personal during business hours. There are two private rooms with no locks on the doors. There are also two cameras, one outside by the patio and one by the reception area.

During further discussion, Ms. Mc Lennon stated they have submitted an updated certification for Erin Westin; however, Lucy Kells' updated certification is still pending. She will provide Ms. Kells' updated certificate as soon as possible.

No members of the public addressed the Commission.

After discussion, Commissioner Madarian and Vice President Gonzalez noted this item will be continued to the next meeting where there is a quorum and would recommend approval of the application.
